The purpose of this scholarship is to help high school graduates get started in college and, in doing so, enhance the community. All female applicants must either live in or attend high school in Mequon-Thiensville.

Our application and questionnaire are enclosed, and we call your attention to our specific eligibility requirements:

Eligibility requires that a young woman in her senior year of high school, intending to start college in the fall, have the potential to make the world a better place. Applicants need not necessarily be above average students, but should show the personality, strength of character, and interest in community service to suggest that they might improve the community around them.

A committee from the Junior Woman's Club of Mequon-Thiensville will select the recipient.

The scholarship check will be disbursed directly to the college or accredited institution upon proof of registration.

All interested female high school students should complete the application, along with the necessary references, and return by April 15. The selected recipient will be notified by May 1.
